7 An Act relating to intoxicating liquors; requiring
8 display of certain sign; providing language for sign;
9 providing dimensions for sign; providing penalty for
failure to display sign; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 516.1 of Title 37, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Every location that is licensed pursuant to Title 37 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes to sell alcoholic beverages or low-point beer
18 products at retail in this state shall post conspicuously and keep
19 posted at the place of business a sign, as specified by the
20 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission, stating the
21 following in both English and Spanish: "WARNING: Obtaining forced
22 labor or services is a crime under Oklahoma Law. Call the national
23 human trafficking hotline: 1-888-373-7888. You may remain
24 anonymous."

1 B. The sign must be at least eight and one half (8 1/2) inches
2 high and eleven (11) inches wide displayed in a conspicuous manner
3 clearly visible to the public and employees. The English notice
4 must cover approximately two-thirds (2/3) of the sign and the
5 Spanish notice must cover approximately one-third (1/3) of the sign.

6 C. When a person violates subsection A of this section, the
7 Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission shall impose
8 an administrative fine of not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for
9 each day a violation occurs. Each day a violation is continuing
10 shall constitute a separate offense.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
