7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalty; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1743 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person who:

16 1. Obtains towing or automotive mechanic services for a motor
17 vehicle from a person who is primarily engaged in the business of
18 providing towing or automotive mechanic services; and

19 2. Subsequently takes possession of the motor vehicle and does
20 not compensate the person who rendered said service,
21 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of misdemeanor punishable by
22 incarceration in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or
23 by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both
24 such fine and imprisonment.
