6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; requiring any rule  
8 adopted by the State Board of Education relating to  
9 cocurricular and extracurricular programs to exclude  
10 certain activities from a ten-day absence  
11 requirement; requiring Internal Activities Review  
12 Committees to perform certain duties; providing for  
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-105.1 of Title 70, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Any rules adopted by the State Board of Education  
19 concerning minimal interruptions of the instructional program  
20 relating to cocurricular and extracurricular programs shall exclude  
21 the following activities from a ten-day absence requirement:

- 22 1. FFA activities; and
- 23 2. 4-H activities.

24 B. Each Internal Activities Review Committee as appointed by  
the board of education of each school district shall review and

1 recommend the maximum number of absences allowed for participation  
2 in FFA and 4-H activities.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
