7 An Act relating to state government; allowing
8 legislators to opt out of state-provided health
9 insurance benefits; specifying that any savings
10 remain with the state; requiring certain affidavit;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1308.3 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any member of the Legislature may opt out of health insurance
18 plan coverage offered pursuant to the State and Education Employees
19 Group Health and Life Insurance Plans, provided that the legislator
20 is currently covered by a separate health insurance plan. Any
21 legislator opting out of coverage pursuant to this section shall
22 sign an affidavit attesting that the legislator is currently covered
23 and does not require state-provided health insurance. Any savings
24 realized by the state as a result of a legislator opting out of
health insurance plan coverage shall be retained by the state.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
