7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
8 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-835, which relates to
9 administration of medication to a resident of a
10 residential care home; allowing any employee to
assist a home resident with the use of prescription
nebulizers or inhalers; and providing an effective
date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-835, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1-835. Administration of medication to a resident of a
17 home shall be administered by a person who has obtained appropriate
18 training from a technology center school or institution of higher
19 education, provided, this requirement shall not prohibit any
20 employee from assisting a home resident with the use of prescription
21 nebulizers or inhalers.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
