6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1636, which relates to  
9 the Oklahoma Welding Act; modifying certification  
10 fee; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1636, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1636. A. The certification fee for each welder shall  
16 be ~~Twenty five Dollars (\$25.00)~~ Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00). An  
17 additional fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid if the welder's  
18 certification has expired prior to renewal. The certification fee  
19 for each welding inspector shall be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).  
20 The certification fee for each testing facility shall be Two Hundred  
21 Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

22 B. Certificates for welders and testing facilities and welding  
23 inspectors shall be issued for a period of one (1) year, and shall  
24 be renewed by January 1 of each year for testing facility applicants

1 and welding inspectors, and on the last day of the welder  
2 applicant's birth month; provided, however, that no welder applicant  
3 shall be required to renew his license more than once during any  
4 twelve-month period. Failure to renew the certificates within one  
5 (1) year of expiration shall require recertification.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
