6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2001, Section 11-903, as amended by Section 1,
9 Chapter 164, O.S.L. 2005 (47 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
10 11-903), which relates to negligent homicide;
11 modifying penalty; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-903, as
14 amended by Section 1, Chapter 164, O.S.L. 2005 (47 O.S. Supp. 2009,
15 Section 11-903), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 11-903. A. When the death of any person ensues within
17 one (1) year as a proximate result of injury received by the driving
18 of any vehicle by any person in reckless disregard of the safety of
19 others, the person so operating such vehicle shall be guilty of
20 negligent homicide.

21 B. Any person convicted of negligent homicide shall be punished
22 by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for
23 not more than three (3) years, or by imprisonment in the county jail
24 for not more than one (1) year or by a fine of not less than One

1 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars
2 (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

3 C. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall revoke the license
4 or permit to drive and any nonresident operating privilege of any
5 person convicted of negligent homicide.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
