7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalty; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1791 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person who enters into a valid residential rental agreement,
16 and then maliciously, willfully, or recklessly causes, permits, or
17 allows the injury, damage or defacement of the rental property that
18 is subject to the terms of the rental agreement shall, upon
19 conviction, be guilty of:

- 20 1. A misdemeanor if the injury, destruction or defacement
21 causes a loss valued at less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00);
22 or
23 2. A felony if the injury, destruction or defacement causes a
24 loss valued at Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or more.
