6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 353.13A, as last
9 amended by Section 12, Chapter 321, O.S.L. 2009 (59
10 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 353.13A), which relates to
11 prescriptions; clarifying language; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 353.13A, as
15 last amended by Section 12, Chapter 321, O.S.L. 2009 (59 O.S. Supp.
16 2009, Section 353.13A), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 353.13A A. ~~Prescriptions~~ A prescription received by
18 other than written communication shall be promptly recorded in
19 writing by the pharmacist. The record made by the pharmacist shall
20 constitute the original prescription to be filled by the pharmacist.

21 B. Pharmacists may dispense prescriptions for dangerous drugs
22 and controlled dangerous substances specified in Section 581 of this
23 title for ocular abnormalities prescribed by optometrists licensed
24 by the Oklahoma Board of Examiners in Optometry. All prescriptions

1 issued by licensed optometrists shall include the license number of
2 the optometrist as assigned by the Oklahoma Board of Examiners in
3 Optometry.

4 C. A filled prescription label shall include the name and
5 address of the pharmacy of origin, date of filling, name of patient,
6 name of prescriber, directions for administration, and prescription
7 number. The symptom or purpose for which the drug is being
8 prescribed may appear on the label, if provided by the practitioner
9 and the patient or the patient's authorized representative so
10 requests. If the symptom or purpose for which a drug is being
11 prescribed is not provided by the practitioner, the pharmacist may
12 fill the prescription order without contacting the practitioner,
13 patient, or the patient's representative. The label shall also
14 include the trade or generic name, and the quantity and strength of
15 the drug therein contained, except when otherwise directed by the
16 prescriber. This requirement shall not apply to prescriptions or
17 medicines and drugs supplied or delivered directly to patients for
18 consumption on the premises while admitted to any hospital or mental
19 institution.

20 D. No prescription shall be written in any characters, figures
21 or ciphers other than in the English or Latin language, generally in
22 use among medical and pharmaceutical practitioners.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
