6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;  
8 authorizing Department of Corrections to provide  
9 Braille translation services by inmates; directing  
10 Department of Corrections to establish a training  
11 program; providing for promulgation of rules and  
12 procedures; providing for codification; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 549.3 of Title 57, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Department of Corrections may enter into a contract for  
19 the services of prisoners to translate and produce Braille books and  
20 materials for blind and visually impaired persons within the State  
21 of Oklahoma. The Department may sell Braille books and materials  
22 produced by prisoners confined in facilities of the Department of  
23 Corrections.

24 B. The Department of Corrections shall establish a Braille  
translation training program for inmates qualified to participate in

1 such program. The Department shall promulgate rules and procedures  
2 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
