6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Oklahoma State Bureau of
8 Investigation; authorizing sale of property;
9 directing the transfer of monies from property sale;
10 creating an exception; establishing the OSBI Real
11 Property Revolving Fund; providing for codification;
12 providing for noncodification; providing an effective
13 date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. On or after September 1, 2010, the Oklahoma State Bureau of
18 Investigation is authorized to sell the following described property
19 in Oklahoma County in whole or in part:

20 Legal Description of property to be sold.

21 A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 24, Township 12 North,
22 Range 3 West of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma,
23 described as:

24 COMMENCING at the northwest corner of said NW/4;

1 Thence N89°30'53"E on the north line of said NW/4 (the bearing
2 upon which this description is based) a distance of 618.00 feet
3 to the Point of Beginning;

4 Thence continuing N89°30'53"E on North line of said NW/4 a
5 distance of 252.00 feet;

6 Thence S00°13'08"E parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a
7 distance of 280.00 feet;

8 Thence S89°30'53"W parallel with the North line of said NW/4 a
9 distance of 360.00 feet;

10 Thence N00°13'08"W parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a
11 distance of 161.65 feet;

12 Thence N89°30'53"E parallel with the North line of said NW/4 a
13 distance of 108.00 feet;

14 Thence N00°13'08"W parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a
15 distance of 118.35 feet to the Point of Beginning;

16 The above description has a gross area of 2.02 acres more or
17 less subject to easements and rights-of-way of record.

18 Such sale shall be contingent upon submission of the sale of
19 this property for public auction or sealed bids by the Oklahoma
20 State Bureau of Investigation.

21 B. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is directed to
22 transfer any monies received from the sale of the property described
23 in subsection A of this section to the Oklahoma State Bureau of

1 Investigation to the OSBI Real Property Revolving Fund as
2 established in Section 2 of this act.

3 C. With respect to this section and Section 2 of this act, the
4 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall not be subject to the
5 requirements of Section 129.4 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 150.19b of Title 74, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
10 for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to be designated the
11 OSBI Real Property Revolving Fund. The fund shall be a continuing
12 fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
13 any monies received from the sale of real property by the agency.
14 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund may be budgeted and
15 expended by the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation only after
16 transfer or appropriation by the Legislature.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

18 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
19 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
