7 An Act relating to marriage and family; amending 43  
8 O.S. 2001, Section 104, which relates to  
9 jurisdictional authority of certain court; clarifying  
10 language; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43 O.S. 2001, Section 104, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 104. A court may exercise personal jurisdiction over a  
16 person, whether or not a resident of this state, who lived within  
17 this state in a marital or parental relationship, or both, as to all  
18 obligations for alimony and child support where the other party to  
19 the marital relationship continues to reside in this state. When  
20 the person who is subject to the jurisdiction of the court has  
21 departed from the state, ~~he~~ that person may be served outside of the  
22 state by any method that is authorized by the statutes of this  
23 state.
