6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state emblems; amending 25 O.S.
8 2001, Section 91, as amended by Section 1, Chapter
9 181, O.S.L. 2006 and Section 2, Chapter 181, O.S.L.
10 2006 (25 O.S. Supp. 2009, Sections 91 and 91a), which
11 relate to the state flag; changing the word Oklahoma
12 on the state flag; granting an exception to the duty
13 of certain state entities to display the official
14 state flag; requiring state agencies to utilize
15 certain statewide contract to purchase certain flags
16 for certain period; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2001, Section 91, as
19 amended by Section 1, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 2006 (25 O.S. Supp. 2009,
20 Section 91), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 91. A. The banner, or flag, of the design prescribed
22 by Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 25, Third Legislature of the
23 State of Oklahoma shall be, and it hereby is superseded and replaced
24 by the following design, to wit:

25 A sky blue field with a circular rawhide shield of an American
26 Indian Warrior, decorated with six painted crosses on the face

1 thereof, the lower half of the shield to be fringed with seven
2 pendant eagle feathers and superimposed upon the face of the shield
3 a calumet or peace pipe, crossed at right angles by an olive branch,
4 as illustrated by the design accompanying this resolution, and
5 underneath said shield or design in white letters shall be placed
6 the word "~~Oklahoma~~" "Oklahoma!", and the same is hereby adopted as
7 the official flag and banner of the State of Oklahoma.

8 B. The standard design and colors in the state flag shall be as
9 follows:

10 1. The Osage Indian warrior's circular rawhide shield of amber
11 buckskin is center upon a field of French Blue. On the face of the
12 shield shall be six small gold brown crosses that match the thongs
13 lacing the edge of the shield. The vertical bar of each cross shall
14 be twenty-five percent (25%) longer than the horizontal bar, the
15 lower width line of which shall be placed at the fifty percent (50%)
16 mark of the vertical bar and the top width line shall be placed at
17 the top twenty-five percent (25%) mark of the vertical bar. The
18 width of the horizontal bar shall be seventy-five percent (75%) of
19 the vertical bar;

20 2. The edge of the lower half of the shield shall be fringed
21 with seven pendant eagle feathers of white tipped with gold brown;

22 3. Across the face of the shield at right angle shall be a
23 calumet or Indian pipe of peace, which shall have a ruby red bowl,
24 flesh stem and be decorated with a ruby red tassel at the end.

1 Above the calumet, lying at a right angle shall be an olive branch
2 of Dartmouth green; and

3 4. The name ~~Oklahoma~~ "Oklahoma!" in white letters shall appear
4 under the shield on the face of the flag.

5 C. The standard colors used in production of the state flag
6 shall be:

7 1. Pantone Matching System, Pantone Inc., latest edition:

8 a. field: French Blue PMS 285c,

9 b. shield: amber PMS 465c,

10 c. feathers shading: flesh and gold brown combination
11 PMS 486c and PMS 174c,

12 d. crosses and thongs: gold brown PMS 174c, and

13 e. calumet: stem of pipe flesh PMS 486c, body of pipe
14 and tassel ruby red PMS 195c, and olive branch
15 Dartmouth green PMS 554c; and

16 2. Colors shall be colorfast and shall not bleed one into
17 another.

18 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 181, O.S.L.
19 2006 (25 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 91a), is amended to read as
20 follows:

21 Section 91a. ~~It~~ A. Except as otherwise provided for in
22 subsection B of this section, it shall be the duty of all state
23 agencies and boards of education of this state to display the state

1 flag with the standard design and colors as specified in Section 91
2 of ~~Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

3 B. Upon enactment of the change in the official flag and banner
4 of the State of Oklahoma as provided for in this act, state agencies
5 and boards of education of this state may continue to display flags
6 with the design adopted as the official state flag and banner prior
7 to the effective date of this act until the normal replacement cycle
8 or until that flag is replaced because of damage or wear, at which
9 time the state agency or board of education shall replace that flag
10 with the official state flag and banner as specified in Section 91
11 of this title.

12 C. State agencies shall continue to utilize the current
13 mandatory statewide contract in place for state agencies and
14 purchase flags with the design adopted as the official state flag
15 and banner prior to the effective date of this act until the
16 inventory of such flags from the primary vendor of the statewide
17 contract is depleted.

18 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
