6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 475.1, as amended by
9 Section 1, Chapter 115, O.S.L. 2005 (59 O.S. Supp.
10 2009, Section 475.1), which relates to engineering
11 and land surveying; clarifying language; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 475.1, as
15 amended by Section 1, Chapter 115, O.S.L. 2005 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009,
16 Section 475.1), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 475.1 In order to safeguard life, health and property,
18 and to promote the public welfare, the practice of engineering and
19 the practice of land surveying in this state are ~~hereby~~ declared to
20 be subject to regulation in the public interest. It shall be
21 unlawful to practice or to offer to practice engineering or land
22 surveying in this state, as defined in the provisions of Section
23 475.1 et seq. of this title, or to use in connection with any name
24 or otherwise assume or advertise any title or description tending to
convey the impression that any person is ~~an engineer~~, a professional

1 engineer, land surveyor or professional land surveyor, unless such
2 person has been duly licensed under the provisions of Section 475.1
3 et seq. of this title. The practice of engineering or land
4 surveying shall be deemed a privilege granted by the state through
5 the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and Land
6 Surveyors, based on the qualifications of the individual as
7 evidenced by a certificate of licensure, which shall not be
8 transferable.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
