7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Concurrent Resolution supporting the establishment  
9 of an Oklahoma Music Trail; directing certain public  
10 entities to cooperate and coordinate the Oklahoma  
11 Music Trail; and directing distribution.

12  
13 WHEREAS, the establishment of an Oklahoma Music Trail would be  
14 of great benefit to tourism and economic development for or in the  
15 State of Oklahoma; and

16 WHEREAS, site locations on the Oklahoma Music Trail would be  
17 places of significance with respect to the musical heritage of  
18 Oklahoma, including residences, commercial buildings or other  
19 structures that highlight the lives, careers and musical  
20 achievements of musicians born in the state or who spent a  
21 substantial or significant part of their musical career in Oklahoma;  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame and Museum would be the  
24 logical entity to provide support for the Oklahoma Music Trail and

1 select and coordinate a coalition of music historians and scholars  
2 who could develop a list of the most notable musical sites that  
3 memorialize an individual, place or event within the state for  
4 inclusion along the Oklahoma Music Trail; and

5 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Music Hall of Fame and Museum in  
6 partnership with the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the  
7 Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Film and Music Commission  
8 and the Department of Transportation could also coordinate, plan,  
9 and provide administrative support for the Oklahoma Music Trail; and

10 WHEREAS, a detailed "Oklahoma Music Trail" map, brochure and  
11 website could promote the history, heritage, legends, and folklore  
12 that characterize the musical heritage of Oklahoma and dedicated  
13 markers along the Trail would honor the various musical sites  
14 selected for inclusion along the Trail.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
16 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
17 CONCURRING THEREIN:

18 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature supports the establishment of an  
19 Oklahoma Music Trail.

20 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature direct the Oklahoma Music Hall of  
21 Fame and Museum, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the  
22 Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Film and Music Commission  
23 and the Department of Transportation to cooperate and coordinate

1 activities in a partnership to establish, maintain, and promote the  
2 Oklahoma Music Trail.

3 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma  
4 Music Hall of Fame and Museum, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
5 Department, the Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Film and  
6 Music Commission, and the Department of Transportation.
