6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
8 to refer to the people for their approval or  
9 rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of  
10 the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 8F to  
11 Article X; providing an ad valorem tax exemption for  
12 disabled troopers; limiting eligibility; allowing  
13 Legislature to enact implementing legislation;  
14 providing ballot title; and directing filing.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
16 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
19 the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of  
20 Oklahoma by adding a new Section 8F to Article X thereof, to read as  
21 follows:

22 Section 8F. A. Despite any provision to the contrary,  
23 beginning January 1, 2010, each head of household who has been a  
24 Trooper with the Oklahoma Highway Patrol and who has either been  
certified by the United States Social Security Administration to be  
one hundred percent (100%) disabled or would be certified by the

1 applicable test of the United States Social Security Administration  
2 to be one hundred percent (100%) disabled and whose disability was  
3 sustained in action or an accident while working in an official  
4 capacity as a Trooper or resulting from disease contracted while in  
5 such capacity or the surviving spouse of such head of household  
6 shall be entitled to claim an exemption for the full amount of the  
7 fair cash value of the homestead.

8 B. In order to be eligible for the exemption authorized by this  
9 section, the individual shall be required to prove residency within  
10 the State of Oklahoma and must have previously qualified for the  
11 homestead exemption authorized by law or be eligible for the  
12 homestead exemption pursuant to law.

13 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
14 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
15 the following form:

18 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

19 This measure adds a new section 8F to Article 10 of the  
20 Constitution. It creates a homestead property tax exemption for  
21 disabled Highway Patrol Troopers. In order to qualify the  
22 trooper must be injured in the line of duty as a trooper.
