6 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
9 to refer to the people for their approval or
10 rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of
11 the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 8G to
12 Article X; providing ad valorem tax exemption for
13 certain day care facilities; providing ballot title;
14 and directing filing.

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
16 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

17 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
19 the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
20 Oklahoma by adding a new Section 8G to Article X thereof, to read as
21 follows:

22 Section 8G. There shall be exempt from ad valorem taxation the
23 real property and improvements consisting of a child care center
24 certified by the Department of Human Services as a three-star
facility or such other system as the Department of Human Services

1 may use in order to provide its highest rating for a child care
2 facility.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
5 the following form:

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It would add a
10 new Section 8G to Article 10. It would provide a property tax
11 exemption for a certain type of child care facility. The child
12 care facility would have to be rated by the Department of Human
13 Services. The rating would have to indicate that the day care
14 had three stars. Three stars indicates the highest rating
15 available. The Department of Human Services could use some
16 other system to indicate that a child care facility has the
17 highest possible rating.
