6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution proclaiming Sunday, April 18, 2010, as
8 Church Women United Day; recognizing the display of
9 the Ribbons of Tangible Hope; and directing
10 distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Church Women United, started in December, 1941, is an
13 ecumenical movement that brings a diverse group of women from the
14 United States and Puerto Rico together into one community of prayer,
15 advocacy and service; and

16 WHEREAS, Church Women United in Oklahoma engages women
17 representing seventeen supporting denominations and participating
18 Christian women; and

19 WHEREAS, on April 18, 2010, at 2:30 p.m. on the South Plaza of
20 the State Capital, Ribbons of Tangible Hope will be displayed to
21 further the vision of celebration of the beauty and importance of
22 life; and

23 WHEREAS, on April 19, 2010, members of Church Women United will
24 gather in their home communities, again, to display the Ribbons of

1 Tangible Hope in an effort to expand the celebration of the beauty
2 and importance of life, with a culture of peace.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
4 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives proclaims Sunday,
6 April 18, 2010, as Church Women United Day and further recognizes
7 the day and the display of the Ribbons of Tangible Hope as a symbol
8 of the joining of all humanity in protecting life on Earth.

9 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Lynne Bussell,
10 National Secretary of Church Women United.
