7 A resolution commending Millard C. Pickering.

11 WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering and wife, Susanne, are  
12 long-time residents of the City of Sapulpa, Oklahoma; and

13 WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering graduated from the  
14 University of Tulsa College of Law in 1985, is a practicing attorney  
15 and consultant and also serves as Assistant Professor of Criminal  
16 Justice at Tulsa Community College; and

17 WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering joined the Elks at  
18 Bristow Lodge No. 1614 in 1976 serving as Exalted Ruler and a  
19 Director of the State Major Projects; and

20 WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering transferred his  
21 membership to Sapulpa Lodge No. 1118 in 1991, served on numerous  
22 committees and projects, and was elected to the Board of Trustees in  
23 1998 serving as Chairman in 1998, 2005, 2006, and 2007; and

1       WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering was appointed State  
2 Chairman of the Laws and Resolutions Committee of the Oklahoma Elks  
3 Association in 1995, holding that position until 2008; and

4       WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering was elected and served as  
5 Northeast District Vice President in 1999-2002; and

6       WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering was appointed  
7 Parliamentarian to the Oklahoma Elks Association in 1998 serving  
8 until 2008; and

9       WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering has served the Grand  
10 Lodge as District Deputy in 2001, Area 6 Member of the Committee on  
11 Judiciary 1998-2006, Member of the Grand Lodge Resolutions Committee  
12 and its Chairman in 2002; Parliamentarian of the Grand Lodge in  
13 2003-2004; National Chairman of the Committee on Judiciary 2005-  
14 2006; Commissioner of Grand Lodge Pardon Commission 2005-2006; and  
15 was appointed to a five-year term as Justice of the Grand Forum in  
16 2006, currently serving as Senior Justice; and

17       WHEREAS, President Millard C. Pickering was elected President-  
18 Elect 2008 and installed as President of the Oklahoma Elks  
19 Association in April of 2009; and

20       WHEREAS, under President Millard C. Pickering's leadership, the  
21 membership of the forty-two Oklahoma Elks Lodges have contributed  
22 over \$2,618,434.08 in cash and service to over one-half million of  
23 Oklahoma's youth, distinguished veterans, and those in need.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives does hereby commend
