7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Concurrent Resolution declaring February 25, 2009,
9 "Ronald Reagan Day" in the State of Oklahoma; urging
10 all citizens to take cognizance of this event and
participate in its observance; and directing

14 background, worked throughout his life serving freedom and advancing
15 the public good, having been employed as an entertainer, union
16 leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of California, and President

18 WHEREAS, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President,
19 he inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation

21 WHEREAS, during Mr. Reagan's presidency he worked in a

12 | Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for millions of people.

14 | OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
15 | CONCURRING THEREIN:

16 | THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature declares February 25, 2009,
17 | "Ronald Reagan Day" in the State of Oklahoma.
