9 A Concurrent Resolution encouraging Oklahoma  
10 employers to allow employees who are veterans to take  
11 Veterans Day off with pay.

13 WHEREAS, Oklahoma veterans have served this country and have  
14 dedicated themselves to the defense of America; and

15 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma honors veterans with Veterans  
16 Day; and

17 WHEREAS, many Oklahoma veterans are not able to enjoy this day  
18 in their honor because their employers require their presence on  
19 Veterans Day; and

20 WHEREAS, Oklahoma employers could demonstrate their respect for  
21 veterans by allowing them to celebrate Veterans Day with a paid  
22 holiday.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
2 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE  
3 CONCURRING THEREIN:

4 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature encourages all private Oklahoma  
5 employers to honor employees who are veterans of the United States  
6 Armed Forces by allowing them to take Veterans Day off with pay.
