6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending
8 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-553, which relates to bone
9 marrow donation education; modifying language; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 1-553, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1-553. A. If funds are available, the Oklahoma Medical
15 Center shall design and implement a statewide general public
16 education program concerning:

- 17 1. The need for bone marrow donors;
- 18 2. The procedures required to become registered as a potential
19 bone marrow donor, including procedures for determining the tissue
20 type of a person; and
- 21 3. The medical procedures a donor must undergo to donate bone
22 marrow or other sources of blood stem cells.

23 B. If funds are available, the Oklahoma Medical Center shall
24 make special efforts to educate and recruit citizens of this state

1 with a special emphasis on minority populations to volunteer as
2 potential bone marrow donors. Means of communication may include,
3 but not be limited to, use of newspapers, radio and television, and
4 placement of educational materials in appropriate health care
5 facilities, blood banks and agencies of the state and political
6 subdivisions of the state. If funds are available, educational
7 materials shall be provided by the Oklahoma Medical Center to all
8 places where ~~driver's~~ driver licenses and licenses for identification
9 only are issued or renewed.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
