5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,  
7 Section 7308-1.8, which relates to the Juvenile Sex  
8 Offender Registration Act; clarifying language; and  
9 providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 7308-1.8, is  
11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 7308-1.8. A. A juvenile sex offender who fails to  
13 register or provide notification of a change of name or address is  
14 guilty of a misdemeanor.

15 B. A parent or guardian who has custody and control of a  
16 juvenile sex offender commits a misdemeanor offense of failure to  
17 supervise a child if the juvenile offender fails to register or  
18 provide notification of a change of name or address as required by  
19 ~~this act~~ the Juvenile Sex Offender Registration Act. A person  
20 convicted of this offense is punishable by a fine of not more than  
21 One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
