6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to game and fish; amending 29 O.S.
8 2001, Section 5-102, which relates to tagging
wildlife to be removed from commercial hunting areas;
9 stating fee; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 5-102, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 5-102. A. No person may remove any propagated or
15 released wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport which are
16 killed at a commercial hunting area, without attaching a tag to each
17 of such killed wildlife or domesticated animals hunted for sport.

18 B. The ~~tags~~ fee for the tag, supplied by the ~~Commission at~~
19 ~~reasonable cost~~ Department of Wildlife Conservation, shall be Five
20 Dollars (\$5.00) if the animal is donated to the Hunters Against
21 Hunger program. The tag shall contain such information as the
22 ~~Commission~~ Department may require and shall be numbered
23 consecutively.

1 C. Such tag must remain attached to the individual wildlife or
2 domesticated animals hunted for sport until prepared and consumed
3 and shall not be used more than once.

4 D. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
5 section shall be punished by a fine of not less than One Hundred
6 Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
7 by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed sixty (60) days, or
8 by both such fine and imprisonment.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
