9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Merit Protection
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the Executive Director;
16 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Merit
20 Protection Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated
21 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
22 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars
23 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
24 imposed upon the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

11 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
12 each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
15 upon the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission by law shall be set by
16 the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the
17 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall not exceed
18 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Merit Protection
20 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
21 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
22 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
23 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
24

1 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
2 Statutes:
