9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Military Department of the  
11 State of Oklahoma; requiring budgeting in certain  
12 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance  
13 measures; providing for duties and compensation of  
14 employees; providing budgetary limitations; and  
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
18 Military Department of the State of Oklahoma shall budget all funds  
19 in the following categories and amounts:

3 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
7 upon the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma by law shall  
8 be set by the Adjutant General. The Military Department of the  
9 State of Oklahoma for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be  
10 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
11 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
12 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
13 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
14 Statutes:
