9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to Office of Personnel Management;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting the salary of the Director; providing  
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office  
19 of Personnel Management shall budget all funds in the following  
20 categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
8 upon the Office of Personnel Management by law shall be set by the  
9 Administrator. The salary of the Administrator of the Office of  
10 Personnel Management shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
11 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
12 ending June 30, 2010. The Office of Personnel Management for the  
13 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
14 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
15 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
16 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
17 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
