6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to attorneys; authorizing legislative
8 disapproval of certain rules; requiring legislative
9 approval of certain rules and amendments; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 19 of Title 5, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The Legislature may by concurrent resolution disapprove any
16 existing rule of the Code of Judicial Conduct.

17 B. The Legislature shall by concurrent resolution approve or
18 disapprove a proposed new rule or a proposed amendment to the Code
19 of Judicial Conduct prior to such rule taking effect. Any such
20 proposed rule or proposed amendment to a permanent rule shall be
21 approved by both houses of the Legislature or such rule or amendment
22 to a permanent rule shall be deemed disapproved. Any such
23 concurrent resolution shall not require the approval of the
24 Governor, and any such rule deemed disapproved shall be invalid and

1 of no effect regardless of the approval of the Governor of such
2 rule.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
