5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to torts; providing immunity from
7 liability for person making certain report; stating
8 exception; providing for codification; and providing
9 an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7.1 of Title 76, unless there is
13 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 Any person who in good faith and exercising due care in making a
15 report of alleged terrorist activity of another person or persons to
16 a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or agency or other
17 security personnel shall have immunity from any civil or criminal
18 liability that might otherwise be incurred or imposed. This section
19 shall not apply to any person who willfully or recklessly makes a
20 false report to a federal, state or local law enforcement officer or
21 agency or other security personnel.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
