9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Space Industry
11 Development Authority; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
14 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting the salary of the Chief Executive
16 Officer; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Space
20 Industry Development Authority from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
24 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Space Industry Development
Authority by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority shall budget all funds
3 in the following categories and amounts:

9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority by law shall
14 be set by the Chief Executive Officer. The salary of the Chief
15 Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Space Industry Development
16 Authority shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum,
17 payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The
18 Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
20 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
21 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
