6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to driver license and identification
8 cards; allowing for enhanced license and
9 identification cards; authorizing declarations;
10 requiring proof of citizenship and residency;
11 providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-110.4 of Title 47, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Department of Public Safety shall implement a procedure
18 by which an applicant for a driver license or identification card in
19 the State of Oklahoma may receive, for a fee of Thirty Dollars
20 (\$30.00), an enhanced driver license or identification card that is
21 in compliance with the regulations of the Real ID Act of 2005.

22 B. An applicant for an enhanced driver license or
23 identification card must sign a declaration acknowledging that his
24 or her photograph will be used as a facial recognition biometric
25 identifier, and that he or she understands that the biometric

1 identifier will be used in a one-to-many biometric matching system
2 for purposes of verifying the identity of the applicant.

3 C. An applicant for an enhanced driver license or
4 identification card must sign a declaration acknowledging that he or
5 she has been notified that the enhanced driver license or
6 identification card contains a radio frequency identification chip,
7 that he or she has been given written information on the type of
8 information the chip contains and how it may be used, and that
9 tampering with or deactivating the chip will invalidate the enhanced
10 driver license or identification card for purposes of border
11 crossing.

12 D. An applicant for an enhanced driver license or
13 identification card shall provide the Department with satisfactory
14 proof of United States citizenship. United States citizenship may
15 be established by providing at least one of the following pieces of
16 documentation:

- 17 1. A United States passport that is valid or has been expired
18 for no more than five (5) years;
- 19 2. Certified state birth certificate;
- 20 3. Certificate of naturalization;
- 21 4. Certificate of citizenship; or
- 22 5. Department of state consular report of birth abroad.

23 E. An applicant for an enhanced driver license or
24 identification card shall provide the Department with satisfactory

1 proof of residency in the State of Oklahoma as defined in section 6-
2 106 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 F. An enhanced driver license or identification card will not
4 be issued to an applicant who is unable to provide the Department
5 with satisfactory proof required under this section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
