9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Space Industry  
11 Development Authority; requiring budgeting in certain  
12 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance  
13 measures; providing for duties and compensation of  
14 employees; limiting the salary of the Chief Executive  
15 Officer; providing budgetary limitations; and  
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
19 Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority shall budget all funds  
20 in the following categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority by law shall  
6 be set by the Chief Executive Officer. The salary of the Chief  
7 Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Space Industry Development  
8 Authority shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
9 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.  
10 The Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority for the fiscal  
11 year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
12 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
13 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
14 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
15 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
