5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
7 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 487, which relates to
8 the secretary of the State Board of Medical Licensure
9 and Supervision; modifying duty of secretary;
10 modifying date of transmittal of certain official
11 copy; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 487, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 487. A. The State Board of Medical Licensure and
16 Supervision may appoint the secretary to serve as Medical Advisor to
17 the Board and the Board staff. The Board may hire the secretary as
18 an employee of the Board at such hours of employment and
19 compensation as determined by the Board. The Board may hire a
20 licensed allopathic physician to serve as the secretary-medical
21 advisor to the Board and its staff. This position shall be in the
22 exempt unclassified service, as provided for in subsection B of
23 Section 840-5.5 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The secretary
24 shall not be a member of the Board and shall not vote on Board
actions.

1 B. The secretary of the Board shall preserve a true record of
2 the official proceedings of the meetings of the Board. He or she
3 shall also preserve a record of physicians licensed ~~or~~, applying for
4 such license or applying for reinstatement of such license in this
5 state showing:

- 6 1. Age;
- 7 2. Ethnic origin;
- 8 3. Sex;
- 9 4. Place of practice and residence;
- 10 5. The time spent in premedical and medical study, together
11 with the names of the schools attended, and the date of graduation
12 therefrom, with the degrees granted;
- 13 6. The grades made in examination for license or grades filed
14 in application therefor; and
- 15 7. A record of the final disposition of each application for
16 licensure.

17 The secretary of the Board shall, on or before the first day of
18 ~~March~~ May in each year, transmit an official copy of said register
19 for the preceding calendar year, to the Secretary of State for
20 permanent record, a certified copy of which shall be admitted as
21 evidence in all courts of the state.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
