9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Transportation;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting the salary of the Director; providing  
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
16 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
18 Department of Transportation shall budget all funds in the following  
19 categories and amounts:

9       The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
10 each budget category.

11       SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
13 upon the Department of Transportation by law shall be set by the  
14 Director. The salary of the Director of the Department of  
15 Transportation shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
16 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.  
17 The Oklahoma Department of Transportation for the fiscal year ending  
18 June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
19 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
20 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
21 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
22 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
