9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the State Treasurer;
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
19 State Treasurer from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
22 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the Office of the State Treasurer by law.

24 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office
of the State Treasurer shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the Office of the State Treasurer by law shall be set by the
13 Office of the State Treasurer. The Office of the State Treasurer
14 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
15 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
16 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
17 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
18 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
