9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the State Treasurer;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office
18 of the State Treasurer shall budget all funds in the following
19 categories and amounts:

2 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
3 each budget category.

4 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
5 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
6 upon the Office of the State Treasurer by law shall be set by the
7 State Treasurer. The Office of the State Treasurer for the fiscal
8 year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
9 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
10 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
11 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
12 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
