6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments;  
8 prohibiting certain storage of DNA on newborn child;  
9 providing for codification; and declaring an  
10 emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1175 of Title 21, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A laboratory, medical facility, hospital or birthing place is  
16 prohibited from the unauthorized storage, transferring, use or  
17 databasing of DNA from any newborn child without express parental  
18 consent.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
