6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to game and fish; authorizing certain
8 persons to sell certain items under certain
9 circumstances; stating requirements; adding
10 definition; providing for codification; and providing
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-411.1 of Title 29, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Any taxidermist may sell any unclaimed specimen left in his
17 or her possession in excess of one year, provided that such person
18 complies with the following requirements:

19 1. Each taxidermist shall keep on file the name, address,
20 hunting license number, and any other information as may be required
21 by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation relating to the
22 owner of the unclaimed specimen; and

1 2. Each taxidermist may sell the unclaimed specimen for an
2 amount not to exceed the original price for mounting, preserving,
3 tanning, or otherwise preparing the unclaimed specimen.

4 B. As used in this section, "taxidermist" means a person who,
5 for consideration, mounts, preserves, or otherwise prepares the body
6 of any bird, animal, or fish, or any other part thereof, for
7 display.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
