9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Department of Health;
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing
14 budgetary limitations; providing for duties and
15 compensation of employees; limiting salary of
16 Commissioner; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Department
19 of Health from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
22 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
23 the State Department of Health by law.

24 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State
Department of Health shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

12 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
13 each budget category.

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the State Department of Health by law shall be set by the State
17 Commissioner of Health. The salary of the Commissioner shall not
18 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The State Department of Health
20 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
21 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
22 and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special
23 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
24 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
