6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to aerospace; creating the Regional
8 Business Airport Modernization Act; providing short
9 title; authorizing award of grant monies; stating
10 goal of grant program; providing for purpose of grant
11 expenditures; providing authority for the Oklahoma
12 Aeronautics Commission to promulgate necessary rules;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.2 of Title 3, unless there is
18 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Regional
20 Business Airport Modernization Act".

21 B. Contingent upon the provision of appropriated funds
22 designated for the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission, the Commission
23 is authorized to award grants totaling Ten Million Dollars
24 (\$10,000,000.00) to the various municipalities with regional
business airports as set forth in the Oklahoma Airport System Plan

1 adopted by the Commission, for improvements as described in
2 subsection D of this section.

3 C. The goal of the grant program is to modernize regional
4 business airports in Oklahoma for the purpose of accommodating the
5 needs of businesses and industries that utilize those airports.

6 D. Funding may cover the costs for construction or renovation
7 of terminals primarily used for general aviation, hangars used for
8 general aviation aircraft, pavement associated with the construction
9 or renovation of terminals or hangars, and preparation for and
10 improvement or installation of navigational aids for airports and
11 aircraft landings.

12 E. In order to be eligible for a grant, municipalities with
13 regional business airports shall comply with the rules governing the
14 Commission grant program, and any additional rules promulgated by
15 the Commission to administer grants provided for in this section.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
