5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
7 limiting certain copayments; directing the Board of
8 Pharmacy to make certain determination; providing for
9 certain fine; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 374 of Title 59, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Pharmacies shall not charge a copayment for prescription
16 drugs that is greater than the cash value of the prescription drug.

17 B. The Board of Pharmacy shall determine the cash value of
18 prescription drugs on an annual basis based on the median retail
19 price of the prescription drug in the state.

20 C. Pharmacies that violate the provisions of section A of this
21 act may be fined by the Board of Pharmacy in an amount not to exceed
22 Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.

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
