7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 prohibiting certain payments; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 374 of Title 59, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Prescription drug manufacturers in this state shall be
16 prohibited from making payments to generic prescription drug
17 manufacturers in exchange for an agreement to cease or forego
18 production of a generic form of a prescription drug manufacturer's
19 product.

20 B. An out-of-state prescription drug manufacturer that makes a
21 payment to a generic prescription drug manufacturer in exchange for
22 an agreement to cease or forego production of a generic form of a
23 prescription drug nonmanufacturer's product shall be fined by the
24 Board of Pharmacy in an amount equal to ninety percent (90%) of

1 total sales in this state of the prescription drug manufacturer's
2 product for the period of the agreement.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
