6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; levying certain  
8 fee on motorcycles; stating amount of fee; providing  
9 for collection of fee; providing for transfer of  
10 collected revenue to the Motorcycle Safety and  
11 Education Program Revolving Fund; requiring  
12 collection and payment of fee as prerequisite to  
13 licensing or registration of motorcycle; providing  
14 for codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132.6 of Title 47, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. In addition to other vehicle registration fees specified by  
20 law, there is levied and there shall be paid to the Oklahoma Tax  
21 Commission a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) upon every motorcycle  
22 registered pursuant to Section 1132 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma  
23 Statutes for use on roads and highways. The fee shall accrue and  
24 shall be collectible upon each motorcycle registered for use on  
roads and highways under the same circumstances and shall be payable  
in the same manner and times as apply to the registration of

1 motorcycles for use on roads and highways under the provisions of  
2 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the fee  
3 shall be paid in full for the then current year at the time any  
4 vehicle is first registered in a calendar year.

5 B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section  
6 shall be transferred each month to the Department of Public Safety  
7 for deposit in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving  
8 Fund created pursuant to Section 40-123 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma  
9 Statutes.

10 C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this  
11 section shall be a prerequisite to licensing or registration of any  
12 motorcycle.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
