9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Human Services;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for exemptions from certain expenditure
14 limitations; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; providing budgetary limitations; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
19 Department of Human Services shall budget all appropriated and other
20 funds in the following categories and amounts:

16 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
17 each budget category.

18 Receipt and expenditure of unanticipated federal funds awarded
19 the Department of Human Services after July 1, 2009, shall be exempt
20 from expenditure limitations, provided that any such funds used for
21 operations shall be included in the agency's budget work program.

22 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
23 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Department of Human Services by law shall be set by the

1 Director of Human Services. The Department of Human Services for
2 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
3 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
4 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
5 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
6 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
