9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Indian Affairs
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Indian
20 Affairs Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
23 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
24 the Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

7 The Commission shall develop outcome-based performance measures
8 for each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission by law shall be set by
12 the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
13 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Indian Affairs
15 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
16 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
17 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
18 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
19 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
20 Statutes:
