6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to wildlife; amending 29 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 4-114, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter
9 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-114),
10 which relates to hunting and fishing license;
11 authorizing persons under a certain age to purchase
12 certain licenses during a certain period of time; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, as
16 last amended by Section 16, Chapter 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp.
17 2009, Section 4-114), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 4-114. A. All legal residents who have resided in the
19 state for at least six (6) months may purchase lifetime fishing
20 licenses, lifetime hunting licenses or lifetime combination
21 hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation
22 Director.

23 B. 1. The fee for these licenses shall be:

24 ~~1.—Lifetime~~

1 C. Legal resident having proper certification from the United
2 States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor certifying
3 that the person is a disabled veteran may purchase a disability
4 lifetime combination hunting/fishing license from the State Wildlife
5 Conservation Director. The fees for the license shall be as
6 follows:

7 1. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for veterans having a
8 disability of less than sixty percent (60%); and

9 2. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for veterans having a
10 disability of sixty percent (60%) or more.

11 D. The use of the licenses provided in this section are subject
12 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the
13 Wildlife Conservation Commission. Except as otherwise provided for
14 in this section, the lifetime hunting license shall be in lieu of
15 all annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

16 E. Nonresidents may purchase a lifetime nonresident fishing
17 license. The fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty
18 Dollars (\$250.00).

19 F. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a
20 duplicate will be issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation
21 for a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

22 G. A lifetime licensee shall not lose the privileges of such
23 license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

1 H. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsections
2 B, C and E of this section, a person purchasing a lifetime fishing,
3 hunting or combination license shall be required to purchase a
4 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. Each person shall have the
5 stamp in their possession while hunting, fishing, or taking any
6 wildlife. The fee for the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp
7 shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). The fee for the stamp shall
8 be distributed as follows:

9 a. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) from each stamp shall be
10 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created
11 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used to retire
12 the obligations and related expenses as authorized
13 pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma
14 Statutes or to purchase, lease, or purchase easements
15 on real property to be used as public hunting,
16 fishing, and trapping areas; and

17 b. Five Dollars (\$5.00) from each stamp shall be
18 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created
19 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used by the
20 Commission for management of the real property
21 acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the
22 Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with proceeds from the
23 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

1 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall
2 prescribe, by rule, the form, design, and manner of issuance of the
3 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

4 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or
5 defeasance of the obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of
6 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife
7 Land Stamp and Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee
8 requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
