AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The Commission shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
3 upon the Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission by law shall be set by
4 the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
5 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission for
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
8 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
9 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
10 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
11 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
