9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the J.D. McCarty Center for
11 Children with Developmental Disabilities; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
14 performance measures; providing for duties and
15 compensation of employees; limiting salary of
16 Director; providing budgetary limitations; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the J.D. McCarty
20 Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities from any monies
21 not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the
22 State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
23 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
24 to perform the duties imposed upon the J.D. McCarty Center for
Children with Developmental Disabilities by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the J.D.
2 McCarty Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities shall
3 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

7 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental
12 Disabilities by law shall be set by the Cerebral Palsy Commission.
13 The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
14 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
15 The J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities
16 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
17 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
18 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
19 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
20 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
