6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; requiring
8 specified agencies to share information and
9 coordinate investigative and enforcement efforts for
10 certain purpose; authorization for creation of secure
11 database and promulgation of rules; providing for
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8152 of Title 74, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Workers' Compensation
18 Court and Oklahoma Employment Security Commission shall share
19 information and coordinate investigative and enforcement efforts for
20 the purpose of detecting those employers who intentionally
21 misclassify individuals as independent contractors rather than
22 employees for the purpose of affecting procedures and payments
23 relating to withholding and social security, unemployment tax or
24 workers' compensation premiums. The agencies required by this
section to share information and coordinate efforts shall be

1 authorized to create a secure database of information accessible by
2 agency representatives responsible for enforcement and shall be
3 further authorized to enter into contracts and interagency
4 agreements and promulgate such rules as may be necessary to
5 implement this section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
