8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Educational
10 Television Authority; making an appropriation;
11 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
12 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
13 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
14 employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
17 Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise
18 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____
20 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
21 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television
22 Authority by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
 2 Oklahoma Educational Television Authority shall budget all funds in
 3 the following categories and amounts:

9 The Authority shall develop outcome-based performance measures
 10 for each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 13 upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law shall be
 14 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
 15 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
 16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Educational
 17 Television Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall
 18 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
 19 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
 20 capitol and special projects except as may be authorized pursuant to
 21 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
